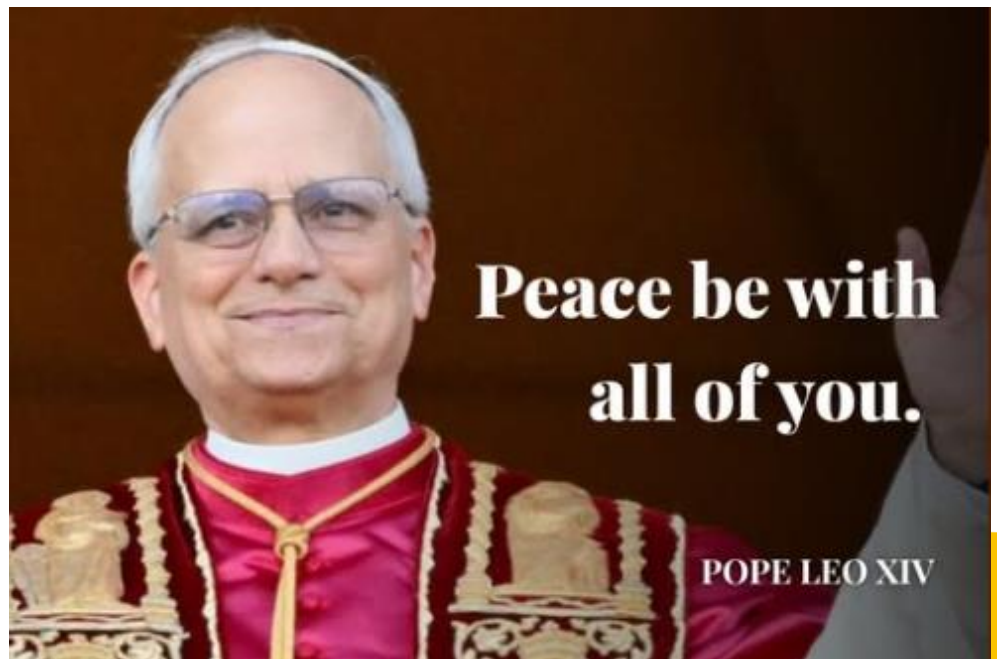

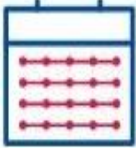
Days missed = years lost

A day here and there doesn't seem like much, but...

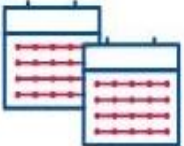
When your child misses just...

1 day per fortnight = **4** weeks  = Over **1** year missed

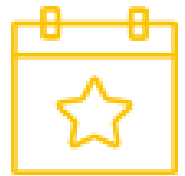
