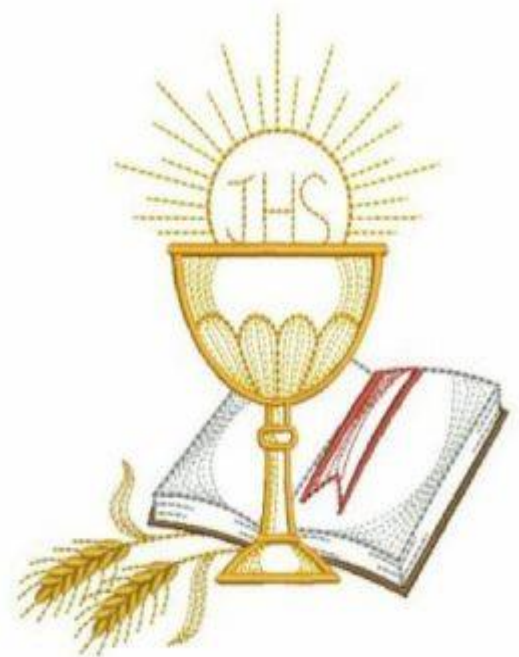

Uniform Reminder:
