Dear our St Peter's community,




## St Peter's Pupil Prayer Group

#### **Year 1 Tamworth Castle Trip**


To support their learning in History, Year 1 visited Tamworth Castle. We learnt about the important people who lived there and we even had to be their servants and create a grand table for a Luncheon!

### **Year 6 100 Years of Stoke Project**

Year 6 took part in 2 sessions led by the University of Staffordshire and children's university. In the first session we explored are heritage. We looked at different items linked with ceramics and had the opportunity to explore each item. We then placed them on a historical timeline and discussed whether they still had a place today. Did you know Josiah Spode create a way of making pottery using animal bones hence the name bone china? We also looked at the future including AI and 3D printing. We discovered that something called alumina is being used to help repair broken bones.
