Year 3 Stone Age Trip and Fossils!

The Year 3 students had an incredible day at Conkers Education Centre, immersing themselves in the fascinating world of the Stone Age. It was a fantastic opportunity for them to explore what life was like during this ancient period. The children participated in an orienteering activity, discovering new facts about the Stone Age, and experienced hands-on learning by building wooden huts inspired by the Mesolithic people. They also got creative by playing music reminiscent of the era and painting cave designs using feathers and sticks, just as our ancestors once did.

The Year 3 students enjoyed an exciting fossil workshop in class, led by Emma from Hoo Zoo. She began with an engaging introduction to fossils, dinosaurs, and prehistoric creatures, sparking the children's curiosity. They then explored the fascinating fossilization process and learned the distinction between body fossils and trace fossils. A highlight of the workshop was when the children got to handle real fossils and ask questions, deepening their understanding. The workshop ended with an unforgettable surprise...a visit from a dinosaur, specially brought from the zoo to our school!

Year 5 went to Sudbury Hall for their Victorian Era History topic and they loved looking at Victorian toys for rich and poor children. They even had the chance to experience what school for Victorian children would have been like in a replica classroom.
