Dear Parents and Carers,

Wow the end of another academic year is suddenly upon us.

I would again like to express my gratitude to you all for the help and support you have shown the school community throughout this academic year, to enable us to continue to raise standards, deliver a curriculum that ensures all children have the best opportunities to reach their full potential. I am sure you will agree it has been a very successful year, the children have shown resilience and in turn excellent attitudes towards their learning, recognised by many visitors to the school and the CSI inspectors during the inspection in March.

I know you would wish to join me in wishing all of our year 6 children a fond farewell as they move on to continue their education journey at their chosen high school, taking with them all they have learned and achieved at St Peter's getting them off to a really good start in September.

In the new academic year following much published government guidance the school will continue to encourage and monitor children's attendance. It is important that children attend school every day and arrive on time. The timings of the school day are as follows:

Start time – gates will open at 8:30am and the gates will then be locked at 8:40am. All children **will be expected** to be in class, ready for their lessons on time every single day.

End of the day – the gates will be opened at 3:00pm and parents will collect children from their classes.

After school clubs will return for all children during the week beginning 11th September. A letter will be sent home during the first week back at school (6th September) with the after school club offer for the half term.

Full school uniform must be worn by all pupils consisting of:

Girls

School cardigan with the school logo on
Grey pinafore /skirt /school trousers (no culottes' or playsuits)
White school blouse (no fashion blouses)
School tie
Grey tights or white socks
Black school shoes (no trainers)

Boys

School jumper with school logo
White shirt
School tie
Grey trousers
Black school shoes (No trainers)

All items of clothing should be clearly marked with your child's name. In the interests of Health and Safety, jewellery must not be worn. This includes earrings, which are not permitted even if covered with a plaster.

Hair should be conventionally cut with no visible lines and should be an appropriate length (not shaven or less than grade 2)

Shoulder length hair should be tied back at all times using a bow or bobble in the school colour (blue and white). Highlights/Lowlights, bleaching or colouring of any kind are not permitted. Small bows or hair bands may be worn but these must be in the school colours (blue and white). If you would like any further clarification, please contact the school office to make an appointment.

As I am sure you will all agree that our children always look smart and it is important that we continue with these high standards in September.

Once again I would like to thank you from the bottom of my heart for your continued support. May God bless you with good health and happiness during the summer holidays. I hope you can all enjoy some quality family time and make cherished memories to treasure forever. I will continue to pray for all our families and our school community.
