What has been happening in school?

Nursery- In Nursery, the children have been learning all about singing and speaking skills by exploring rhymes. They have listened to short stories and discussing what they have listened to. In Maths, the children are learning mathematical songs. In Art, the children are learning how to collage and have also focused on painting our new King, King Charles III.

Reception- Reception are learning all about their body and how it works this half term. They are discussing and learning about germs and hygiene and how to care for our bodies. The children are also learning all about the season of Autumn! In literacy the children are learning how to hold a pencil, write their names and how to write words. They are also learning how to speak in proper sentences and learning new vocabulary.

Year 1- In Maths they are learning about Addition and Subtraction. In English they are exploring the story of Hansel and Gretel. In R.E lessons, they are learning about Families and Celebrations. They have been learning lots about their class Saint, St Francis of Assisi. They had an exciting day on the 4th October, where parents were invited into school to take part in an Inspire Workshop and watch an assembly all about St Francis and how to be a 'Steward of God's creation.' The children have also been on a Local Walk of Cobridge.

Year 2- In Maths year two have been partitioning numbers in different ways. In English they have been reading The Journey Home and writing as the animals in the story. They have read stories from the Old Testament and this week they have read David and Goliath in RE.

Year 3- This term in Maths, Year 3 are learning Place Value up to number digits to 3. For English they are learning how to write their own magic box potion. In science they are learning rocks and soils. In R.E they are learning that we gather as Gods family like our mission statement " Together , one family one community, in Christ." Year 3 have celebrated their class saint assembly on the 28th September. They had a year 3 and 4 football tournament on Friday 7th October.

Year 4- In Math's, Year 4 are learning place value to 1000. In English they are reading 'How To Train Your Dragon.' They are thinking about the characters and their thoughts. For Science they are learning human body organs and the jobs of the body. For R.E they are learning the creation story - what God created- why did he? - and the purpose of us on the world. Year 4 had a football tournament on Friday 7th October.

Year 5- Year 5 had a visit from Leissander the solider! It was an Ancient Greek Workshop. They reenacted a battle using shields and swords. They played Ancient Greek board games, learnt about democracy. After, they wrote on papyrus paper using a reed pen and wrote the Greek alphabet. As well as this, they are learning about Place Value in Maths. They are reading 'Who Let the Gods Out', and in R.E. they are looking at 'Miracles'. Year 5 have had their TT Rockstars competition in the last week of half term.

Year 6- Year 6 are working very hard in Maths focusing on Measurement and Place Value. In English, they have written a diary based on the book 'Letters of the Lighthouse'. In R.E., they are focusing on being 'Followers of Jesus'. In Science, they are learning all about electricity. Year 6 had an exciting trip to Keele University which gave them an opportunity to think about their future. They have also visited Saint Chad's Cathedral, learning about the History and even met the Archbishop.

Special mention to our Year 5 and 6 children who won 3 games out of 6 on Friday 14th October in a Handball competition against other school's at Dimensions.
